ALTERATION & ADDITION, DECKING

The owner of this residence required wheelchair access to all areas of the house, and architect Andrew Scott from ASARCH was appointed to remodel the existing ground floor kitchen, laundry and bathroom to suite.

Andrew's brief was to ensure that all floor surfaces were harmonious and we were to install a new oversized western cedar door leading from the kitchen to a new suspended hardwood deck with privacy screen.

Aware that the home had heritage value and a strict building programme, AOCA was appointed to complete the alteration and addition, and works were completed within time and budget considerations.

The kitchen stonetop was Caesar stone and joinery finished with a combination of beech veneer and polyurethane with mother of pearl handles.

The bathroom design facilitated wheelchair access onto a custom designed shower seat and adjacent the wall hung pan.
